# AEIC Establishes Achievement Awards Program

In the February 2017 AEIC Board of Directors meeting, the Board voted to establish an awards program to acknowledge exceptional individuals and groups from AEIC member companies who have provided significant contributions to advancing the operations of the electric energy industry.

These contributions may include, but not be limited to, the following areas of operations: Safety, Power Delivery, Power Generation, Electric Power Apparatus, Meter and Service, Load Research & Analytics,

The Association of Edison Illuminating Companies Achievement Awards are the Association's most prestigious awards.

Commenting on the creation of the awards program, Terry Waters, AEIC Executive Director, said, "This new awards program provides AEIC the opportunity to formally recognize individuals and groups from member companies for the innovative contributions they have made to advancing operations in our industry. Oftentimes, these individuals have been unsung heroes, and we're pleased to now have an awards program to provide them with the recognition that they so richly deserve."

## How the Awards Program Works

Nominations for the awards may be made by any AEIC Board Member, Committee or Subcommittee Chair, or AEIC member company CEO.

The deadline for submitting nominations is May 1 of each year for awards made in that year, and each nomination must include the following:

1. A completed Nomination Form signed by an AEIC Board Member, Committee or Subcommittee Chair, or CEO of an AEIC member company
2. A description of the achievement, not to exceed three pages of text, photos, and supporting documentation

Nominations are to be submitted to the AEIC Executive Director at [twaters@aeic.org](mailto:twaters@aeic.org) or Executive Director, Association of Edison Illuminating Companies, 600 N. 18th Street, Birmingham, AL 35203.

Upon receipt of nominations, the Executive Director shall submit the nominations to the AEIC Executive Committee for review. Nominations recommended by the AEIC Executive Committee shall then be submitted to the AEIC Board of Directors for review.

Final selection of the award recipients will be determined by the AEIC Board of Directors. The awards will be announced and presented at AEIC's Annual Meeting, held in the Fall of each year.
